1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish a systematic approach to quantify, minimize, and publicly disclose Material Discharges to Water from Raviraj Foils Ltd.'s activities. This policy aims to protect water resources and maintain transparency with stakeholders, ensuring that our operations minimize environmental and human health impacts.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all facilities and operations of Raviraj Foils Ltd., including direct discharges from our activities and, where possible, those within our Area of Influence. The policy covers the quantification, disclosure, management, and review of Discharges to Water.

3. Core Principles

Water Stewardship: We commit to minimizing the environmental impacts of our discharges to water through proactive management and reduction strategies.

Transparency and Public Engagement: We will publicly disclose our discharges and reduction plans, ensuring transparency with all stakeholders, including local communities and affected populations.

4. Discharges to Water

4.1 Quantification and Public Disclosure

Annual Disclosure: Raviraj Foils Ltd. will quantify and publicly disclose Material Discharges to Water from all activities on an annual basis, including those within our Area of Influence, where possible.

Inventory Development: An inventory of discharges, including baselines, will be developed and periodically updated for each facility. This process will involve consultation with qualified specialists, affected populations, and organizations. Site-specific data will be aggregated to provide a comprehensive view of discharges at the entity level.

Impact Assessment: We will assess the potential impact of our discharges on receiving water bodies, including modeling that accounts for aquatic conditions, worst-case scenarios, and the location and type of downstream ecosystems.

4.2 Discharge Management Plans

Plan Implementation: Raviraj Foils Ltd. will implement plans to minimize exposure to, and impacts from, Discharges to Water. These plans will be developed in harmony with applicable regulatory standards and, where necessary, will reference prevailing international standards.

Community Participation: Affected Indigenous Peoples and Local Communities will be empowered to participate in the water monitoring program. We will ensure regular communication of monitoring results to these communities.

Monitoring Program: A comprehensive water monitoring program will be established, including site-specific plans for monitoring equipment and water

sampling locations. The program will also ensure the calibration of all water monitoring equipment.

4.3 Review and Continuous Improvement

Regular Reviews: The discharge management plans will be reviewed at least every five years. Additional reviews will be conducted after any discharge event that exceeds internally or externally mandated limits or following any significant business changes that alter material risks from Discharges to Water.

Trigger-Based Reviews: Irregular or significant adverse monitoring results will trigger an earlier review. Reviews will involve input from affected populations and organizations where applicable.

Plan Improvement: Post-review, any identified improvements will be implemented to ensure the effectiveness of the plans in meeting objectives, stakeholder expectations, and legislative requirements.

5. Public Disclosure and Verification

5.1 Public Disclosure

Disclosure of Plans: The latest versions of the discharge management plans, along with annual progress reports, will be publicly disclosed through the company's website, sustainability reports, and other relevant channels.

Reporting Standards: Public disclosures will align with GRI 303-4 and other relevant reporting standards, ensuring transparency and consistency in communication.
